DUTIES/AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

The Digital Strategic Communication officers, depending on their skill sets, will be tasked with the following:

- Conduct extensive research on online terrorist messaging by tracking, monitoring, evaluating and collecting related materials for the purpose of developing counter narratives;
- Study, analyse and evaluate the impact, reach, vector, and significance of the digital end products;
- Plan, develop, and deliver a number of products, events and conferences;
- Develop expertise and continuity with external partners and collaborators in relevant research fields; and
- Travel and give presentations, when necessary, in SEARCCT's events domestically and internationally.

CANDIDATE SPECIFICATIONS

The post is open to all Malaysian citizens, with the following qualifications/ skills:

- A Bachelor (Hons) degree or equivalent. Candidates with specialisation in International Relations, International Security or Political Science, particularly related to Counter-Terrorism or IT or Digital Animation may be given priority. Those with masters or higher degree holders will also be given preference;
- The candidate should exhibit creativity, excellent organisational skills, meticulous and can work independently;
- Good communication skills in both Bahasa Melayu and English as a requisite; and
- Practical experience in research and analysis, would be an advantage.
